The Greater Greenville Association of REALTORS® Scholarship is awarded to Greater Greenville Area High School Seniors, who meet certain rigid criteria such as academics and leadership potential. Consideration for scholarship funds is determined by scholarship application. Since its creation in 1996, the GGAR Scholarship has provided over \$124,000 in scholarships to Greenville, Laurens, and Pickens County students within the jurisdiction of the Greater Greenville Association of REALTORS®.

GGAR Scholarship funds are raised through the Greater Greenville Association of REALTORS® annual event, "Lobs, Links, and Lanes". This event consists of a golf, tennis and bowling tournament and barbeque dinner.

- Complete only one **original** application and submit it along with supporting documents before 5:00 p.m., March 19, 2010. Applications received after 5:00 p.m., March 19, 2010 will not be considered.
- Applications must be legibly handwritten or typed (application is editable). Applications with incomplete or missing information will be disqualified.
- GGAR will **NOT** accept copies of applications or applications sent via fax or e-mail.
- You will be notified by mail in late April regarding the status of your application.
- Scholarship funds will be presented directly to the selected recipients in June. Recipients will be provided with additional details.
